


For the past 10 years, the Armenian Educational Foundation (AEF) has actively invested in the future of Armenia by providing the gift of education to undergraduate and graduate students enrolled at public, state universities, in Armenia and Artsakh.

Through the generous donation of sponsors at \$1,000 a year per student, coupled with their commitment to the power of higher education, students are awarded scholarships which fully fund the tuition cost of their respective university for either 4 years (undergraduate) or 2 years (graduate).

Because education matters, AEF scholarship recipients are inspired and able to pursue higher learning in designated fields which have the greatest impact on the growth and development of our homeland.

Over the past 10 years, the number scholarship recipients has grown steadily from 21 to 193 (annually) more than 450 bright, capable students being given the opportunity to pursue their educational goals and contribute to securing Armenia's tomorrow.

*I*n addition, AEF has budgeted \$10,000 annually for the next four years to provide scholarships for Syrian-Armenian refugee students attending public universities in Armenia. This academic year (2016-2017), AEF awarded scholarships to 23 Syrian-Armenian students covering 30% of their tuition. AGBU and Gulbenkian funds covered the remaining 70% of these students' tuition expenses.



The Selection Process



Each year, the AEF Scholarship Committee in Yerevan sets out on the difficult task of selecting worthy students from Armenia and Artsakh, who will receive a scholarship to fully fund their university tuition.

In 2016, from an applicant pool of 1,100 students, the Scholarship Committee assumed the challenge of reviewing, screening and selecting 124 new recipients using the following criteria:

- Financial need
- Academic performance
- Family composition
- Village/region of residence (border villages given priority)
- Parents who served in the Artsakh war
- Military service
- Volunteer work
- Essay
- Interview


With great scrutiny, objectivity and utmost transparency, the committee carefully checks each application and assigns a numerical value based


on a matrix. Students earning the highest value are invited for an interview, then ranked again to determine the most worthy recipients. For example, in 2016, after the 1,100 applicants were filtered through the matrix, a total of 325 essays were read from which 225 applicants were invited to an interview.

Once the scholarship recipient is selected, AEF wire transfers the tuition directly to the university on behalf of the student. Then each recipient is closely monitored and must maintain high academic standing in order to continue in the program.

Consistently, this model has proven to be highly effective in culling the most potentially successful students. In fact, in 2016, 17 of our AEF scholarship recipients excelled so notably that they were awarded a tuition-free education by the Armenian government and exited from our roster. These freed-up scholarships were, in turn, awarded to deserving students on the waiting list.

We invite sponsors to Armenia in the summer to take an active part in the selection process and get acquainted with the students more closely.




