

AEF ARMENIA SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM NEWSLETTER

BECAUSE EDUCATION MATTERS

Education is the driving force behind the development and success of Armenia. The Armenian Educational Foundation (AEF), among its numerous educational programs, provides full tuition scholarships to students attending public universities in Armenia and Artsakh. AEF wire transfers each student's tuition directly to the institution providing capable students an opportunity to pursue their educational goals and ultimately contribute to the shaping of Armenia's and Artsakh's future.

Being well aware of employment demands both nationally and globally, this year the Scholarship Committee specifically targeted students in Science, Technology, Engineer ing, Mathematics (STEM) related fields and awarded 89 new scholarships in these majors.

AEF also awarded scholarships covering 30% of the tuition for 23 Syrian-Armenian refugee students (AGBU/Gulbenkian spon sor the other 70%). This specially earmarked \$40,000 fund allocates \$10,000 annually for a period of four years.

Additionally, AEF provided full tuition scholarships to 23 graduate students pursuing their teaching certification.

AEF recognizes the great importance of education, including preparing and graduating students supporting in finding employment in Armenia. The Scholarship Committee arranged for professionals in various fields to present workshops, seminars and group discussions focused on exploring employment opportunities, providing career information and potential internships for our students.

Most inspiring is the prominent growth AEF is enjoying in the number of sponsors resulting in AEF's ability to award greater grateful to those who share our common



Levon Yeghiazaryan

AEF scholarship alumnus, Levon Yeghiazaryan (BA-2010, MA-2013) is making headlines in innovation. Levon, and his colleague, have designed and produced an LED phyto lamp which accelerates the growth of plants by speeding up the process of photosynthesis. The lamps can be used both in greenhouses and enclosed spaces where there is limited or no light. While such lamps already exist, Levon's invention is able to activate an even faster growth rate of plants, is less expensive because of the LED chips that are used, is energy saving and notable for its longevity. Levon is currently pursuing global markets. We are extremely proud of Levon and wish him much success.

Mini-Grants...Powering Civic Engagement

In 2016, AEF initiated a new project to encourage our students in becoming civically active by giving back to their communities as contributing citizens. In an effort to empower the youth, twice a year, AEF offers two \$500 mini-grants to AEF scholarship recipients who initiate a novel proposal to positively impact their community. Students write a proposal identifying a project, describe the existing reality and highlight the positive impact it will make in the community. An implementation plan and timeline are outlined in the proposal along with a detailed accounting of how the funds will be spent. A committee then reviews the proposals and grants the funds based on functionality, sustainability and degree of impact on the community.




